FORMAT:

The Section & District (State tournaments will consist of Singles Girls and Open Division and 5-person teams who are residents from the Host States in two (2) Divisions: Ages 14 & Under and Ages 15-19. In the singles event three (3) games will be bowled to determine advancement. In the team event two (2) games of regular 10-pin bowling will be followed by 5 games of Baker Team Competition to determine advancement. This is a scratch tournament and only actual score are used. There is no carry-over of scores from Sectionals to District, or District (State) to National Championships.

SECTIONS

QUALIFYING ADVANCEMENT: **Sectional Team Event** – 1 out of 4 teams in each division (and any fraction thereof) will qualify for advancement from the Sectional to the District (State) Finals.

Sectional Team Event – 1 out of 8 individuals in each division (and any fraction thereof) will qualify for advancement from the Sectional to the District (State) Finals.

DISTRICT (STATE)

QUALIFYING ADVANCEMENT: **District (State) Team Advancement** – At the District (State) Level, the top three (3) teams in each division will advance to the AAU National JRO Games National Team Competition to be held in Virginia Beach, VA on July 31st through August 2, 2010.

District (State) Singles Advancement – At the District (State) Level, the top ten (10) individuals in each division will advance to the AAU National JRO Games National Singles Competition to be held in Virginia Beach, VA on August 2 & 3, 2010.

MULTIPLE ENTRIES:

Athletes may enter multiple Sectional Team & Singles Competition as many times as there are squad times. See Sectional/District (State) Rules for more details at www.aaubowling.org.
